Aim of the prizes

The aim of these prizes is to foster and reward the academic excellence and quality of the students of the Faculty of Tourism

Addressed to?

This prize is addressed at all students in the Bachelor's Degree in Tourism who fulfil the following requirements during the corresponding academic year. Thus, students must:

- 1. Be enrolled for the first time in a minimum of 60 ECTS in subjects included in the curriculum of the Bachelor's Degree in Tourism (which may include core, compulsory and optional subjects).
- 2. Have obtained a grade other than *Absent* in the examination periods of February and June, in a minimum of 60 ECTS (which may include core, compulsory and optional subjects).

Criteria for the selection of the prize winners

The mark that will determine the winners of the *Logitravel Best Students' Prize* will be calculated in accordance with the following criterion:

- 1. The judges will choose the best marks obtained in the 60 ECTS credits in which the student has enrolled for the first time in this same academic year, and has obtained a grade other than Absent in the examination periods of February and June.
- 2. If there are more than 60 ECTS in the first call during the current academic year with a grade other than Absent in the examination periods February and June, the subjects with the best grades will be the ones selected.
- 3. The average mark will be calculated from the subjects that are chosen.
- 4. The three students with the highest average marks will be awarded the Logitravel Prize to the Best Student in the Bachelor's Degree in Tourism

Terms of the prize

The prizes will be decided during September and this decision shall be communicated to the media and to members of the Faculty of Tourism.

The winners will be contacted by the organisers during the month of September.

The jury reserves the right to declare the prizes void.





Prize amount

THREE Logitravel Prizes to the Best Students will be awarded each academic year.

The value of each prize is **900 euros**, which may only be used to help pay for the student's enrolment in the following academic year in any of the undergraduate or post-graduate studies offered by the Faculty of Tourism.

Jury members

The jury for these prizes shall be made up of:

- The Dean, Vice-Deans and Secretary of the Faculty of Tourism
- A representative from the institution funding the prize (Logitravel)

The jury's verdict will be that agreed on by the majority of votes and the judges' decision will be final and binding.
